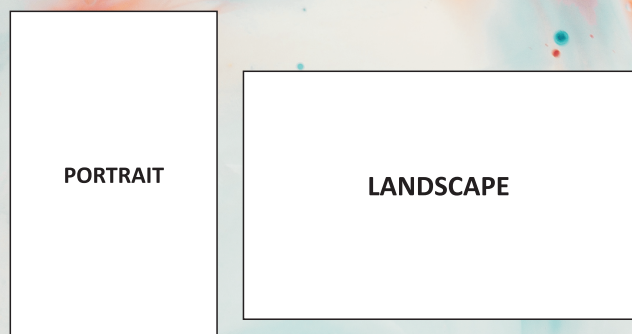

SIZE: AO or A1 – portrait or landscape layout



FONT: Minimum 20 pt
Good contrast between font colour and background

NNA POSTERS - MIN FONT SIZE 20 PT

IMAGES: As you are presenting in a visual medium, we recommend that your poster includes images / diagrams / graphs, as appropriate. If you are using colour images imagine them in black and white to consider if there is sufficient contrast for a person who is colour blind.

TEXT: Try to avoid large blocks of text by using bullet points and/or breaking up into shorter pieces.

This poster is titled 'REVALIDATION' and is from the NMC Nursing & Midwifery Council. It explains what revalidation is and lists the aims of the process. It includes a table with four columns: 'What is revalidation?', 'Revalidation aims to:', 'Professional people', 'Practice effectively', 'Promote safety', and 'Promote professional development and trust'. Each column contains specific points related to the revalidation process.

This poster is titled 'Exploring the Effectiveness of an Interactive, Technology Enabled Learning Tool to Enhance Knowledge in Neonatal Biology for Children's nurses'. It is by Julia Petty, School of Health and Social Work, University of Hertfordshire. The poster includes an introduction, design & methods, results, and implications for practice. It also features a pie chart showing the distribution of knowledge levels before and after the intervention.
